SWE Minnesota Section Scholarship Program Information

- The Minnesota Section of SWE and its corporate partners offer tuition-based scholarships to women engineering and computer science students attending ABET accredited institutions in Minnesota, and North and South Dakota.
- These scholarships are for full time female students studying at one of the specified academic institutions.
- U.S. citizenship may be required for some Corporate Partner Scholarships.
- Past recipients may submit a new application for the current scholarship year. Any given student may only receive a given corporate partner's scholarship once, so repeat applicants may be eligible for a smaller number of the currently offered scholarships.
- Scholarships are awarded on the basis of your potential to succeed in an engineering career; your communication skills; your involvement in extracurricular or community activities and leadership skills you've shown in those activities; your demonstrated work experience and success; and your academic success.
- Applications are judged by a panel of Minnesota SWE professionals, representing different fields of engineering, reviewing the information submitted with this application.
- Recipients will be notified by May 1, with the scholarship applied to the next Fall semester.
- Those students not selected as recipients will be notified via email after May 15.

Application Instructions

- Application for all scholarships offered through our SWE-MN program must be made on this form, accompanied by a current transcript (student issue copy acceptable) and resume. Your single application will be considered for all scholarships offered in any given year.
- Electronically submitted applications must be sent by **midnight on March 15**; mailed applications must be postmarked no later than **March 15**.
